PRAYER THEMES

Using a different theme every day to guide you will not only make your prayer life more focused but enable you to pray for a wide variety of things each week. Here are some suggested prayer themes you could pray through each week. You could also use these topics when you gather with friends or your Connect Group.

01 OUR IDENTITY AND AUTHORITY

Read Psalm 139 & Romans 8:15

Use this theme to ask God for a fresh revelation and understanding of your identity and authority in Christ Jesus. You are loved, secure, accepted and valued in Him. Know that you have purpose in Him and that Jesus, who has all authority, has given you His authority .

02 BE FILLED WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT

Read Psalm 84 & Luke 11:9 - 13

We need the Holy Spirit and we can be filled with Him every day. Pray for a fresh filling of the Holy Spirit in your life today. Pray that you would receive the gifts of the Holy Spirit (1 Cor 12, Rom 12 & Eph 4). As you pray ask the Holy Spirit to empower you with boldness to proclaim and model the Gospel everywhere.

03 CONFESSION, REPENTANCE & FREEDOM

Read Psalm 51 & 2 Chronicles 7:14

Start by asking God if there are any areas in your life that are not honouring to Him (Psalm 139:23-24). As He brings things to mind, confess these to Him and repent knowing that He is faithful to forgive you. As you pray ask God to empower you to withstand any temptation and trial you face and to enable you to walk in freedom every day.

04 TRUSTING GOD

Read Psalm 13 & Matthew 11:28 - 30

Think through any areas in your life in which you are struggling to trust God. Give them to Him and pray that you would be able to wholly trust Him and His plans. We need to partner with God through faith and resist worry, hurry and anxiety which can happen when we don't trust Him.

05 YOUR HOUSEHOLD

Read Psalm 112 & 1 John 5:14

Pray that the Lord's joy will be present in your household today as you spend time praying for those you live with. Take some time to pray through each room in the home and for the presence of God to come.

06 LETCHWORTH GARDEN CITY CHURCH

Read Psalm 34 & Ephesians 1:17-19

Use this theme to pray that LGCC would flourish as a family by love, care and encouragement of one another. Let's pray that we would be devoted people, generous in sharing with others what God has given us, and that our love for one another would be attractive to those who don't know God.

07 NEXT GENERATION

Read Psalm 145 & Deuteronomy 6:6-7

Ask God to bless the next generation at LGCC that He would encourage them to grow in their relationship with Him. Let's pray for grace and wisdom for parents and families as they serve their children. Ask God to help us as a church to encourage, support and disciple well our next generation.

08 UNITY

Read Psalm 133 & Matthew 5:13 - 16

Use this theme to pray for churches and Christian organisations in North Hertfordshire and Bedfordshire. Pray that unity would deepen and those in our communities will increasingly see the Church as one body. Why not pray for someone you know from another church and their fruitfulness .

09 YOUR SPHERE OF INFLUENCE

Read Psalm 95 & Mark 5:19 (MSG)

Spend some time thinking about your places of influence (you have them). Pray that God would use you as a scattered servant to bring His Kingdom where you are. If you have time, go for a prayer walk around your neighbourhood.

10 GOVERNMENT

Read Psalm 67 & I Timothy 2:1-3

Pray for the Prime Minister and the rest of the government, that God would equip them with strength and wisdom in leading and decision-making. Pray for civil servants, government advisers, leaders, and your own MP - that all involved in leading the country would work together to further justice and the good of all.

11 THE NATIONS

Read Psalm 80 & Acts 17:26

God loves the nations and they are all in His hands. Let's pray that God would bless all nations and that His glory would fall. If the UK is not your home nation why not spend time praying for your home nation using some of the themes above.
